What is CSCi?

The Center for Strategic Community Innovation (CSCi) is a nonprofit organization that provides capacity building services to support school districts, nonprofits and public agencies in identifying, testing and applying best practice methods *at the intersection of service systems and neighborhoods.* We are experts in building **Full Service Community Schools** (FSCS) that improve services and reform systems in order to create more equitable communities and successful students.

Community Schools Project

The **Community Schools Project (CSP)** is our flagship initiative whereby we are helping to mobilize the regional Full Service Community Schools "movement" in the Bay Area and beyond. The CSP:

- 1. **Engages, educates and builds partnerships** between school districts, public agencies, community leaders, families and students to establish strong FSCS
- 2. **Develops the capacity** of communities and organizations to build and sustain FSCS by:
 - Convening, developing professional learning communities and networks, such as the Bay Area Community Schools Network, and developing cross-system FSCS collaboration
 - Helping to build partnerships and collaboratives
 - Asset mapping, strategic and program planning, systems development and alignment,
 - Leadership development, coaching, technical assistance and training
 - Supporting policy development
 - Helping cities, districts, and school sites leverage resources and strengthen programs
 - Creating development tools and curricula for use in the field to help create FSCS models
 - Documentation, reports, concept papers and briefs

Who is CSCi?
