- Applications are submitted to the CPCA Board of Directors for approval

SPONSORSHIP FOR MEMBERSHIP

The CPCA Bylaws stipulate criteria for membership and procedures for membership application which include sponsorship for applicants in the clinic, consortium or affiliate category.

Sponsorship of applications for membership requires a current "Community Health Clinic" or "Regional Consortia and Association" member in good standing, and with knowledge of the applicant, give a local perspective on the applicant's compliance with the membership criteria as listed in the Bylaw sections attached.
