



School-Based Health Centers in California: A Growing Trend

In 2000, there were 108 school-based health centers (SBHCs); today, there are 243. As a result, over 257,000 students now have access to a health center at their school.















Services Provided



Sources of Revenue

- Reimbursement through the Child Health and Disability Prevention Program (CHDP), Family PACT, Medi-Cal, health insurance, and EPSDT contracts for mental health services.
- School district contributions or inkind support of space, utilities, and custodial services.
- Sponsoring agency contributions or subsidies.
- Government and private grants.
