
8th – 12th grade students targeted Brief classroom outreach and education on reproductive health topics, rights and resources for students – with a focus on SBHC services


Brief 1:1 health education and sexual health screening assessment with Health Educators, Nurse Practitioners, SON Preceptors and SON students

Why

La Clínica de la Raza – expand reach into middle schools, where youth are not as likely to present on their own

- Increased integration with school, school programs
- Addressing unmet health needs

UCSF School of Nursing – commitment to train providers skilled in working with underserved youth

- need to expand innovative/ alternative clinical placements for students.
- Address unmet health needs
