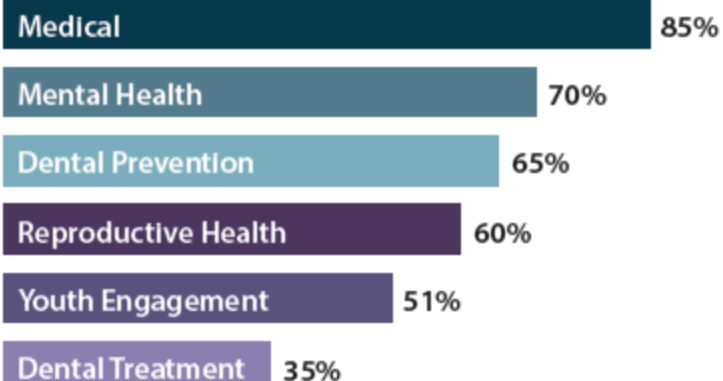
2017-18 SBHC Census

students have access to SBHCs & high-quality health services

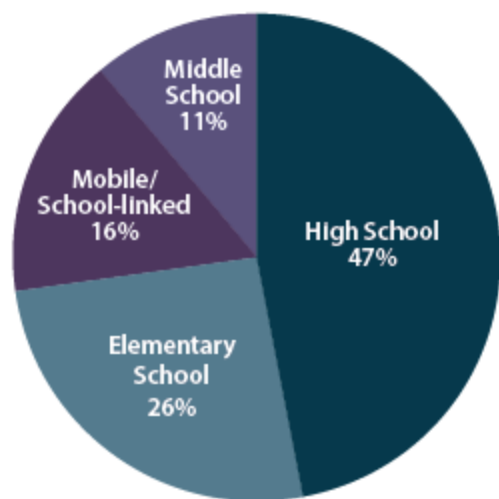


Services Provided

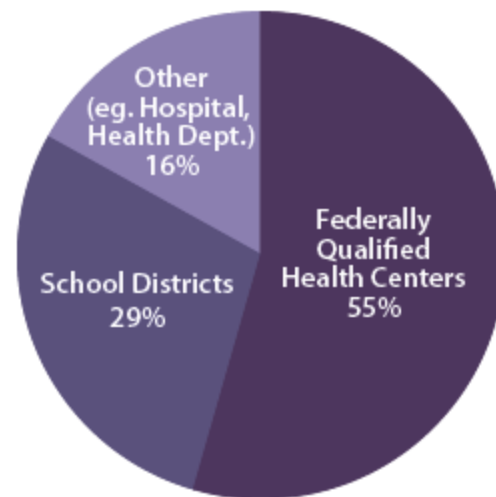


83% of SBHCs serve community
