Career Technical Education (CTE) provides students of all ages with the academic and technical skills, knowledge and training necessary to succeed in future careers and to become lifelong learners. In CA, there are 15 recognized Industry Sectors and 58 Career Pathways.



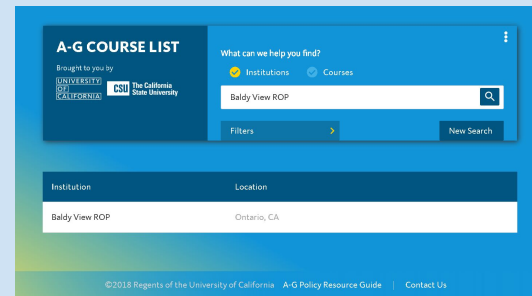
CTE PATHWAY SEQUENCE - Between Level 2 & 3 completes at least 300 hours with a passing grade of C- or better.
 BVROP CLASSES MAY NOT BE REPEATED. STUDENTS MUST PROGRESS TO THE NEXT COURSE.



A CTE pathway is a sequence of two or more CTE courses within a student's area of career interest. Pathways are designed to connect high school classes to college, industry certifications, and/or a career.

Understanding the College/Career Readiness Measure: Prepared

The College/Career Indicator includes measures on how well local educational agencies (LEAs) and schools are preparing students for likely success after graduation. Graduates classified as **Prepared** on this state measure must meet *at least one* of the criteria in the **Prepared** level.

Score of Level 3 "Standard Met" or higher on both English language arts/literacy (ELA) and mathematics

Score of 3 or higher on two AP exams

Leadership/Military Science

Two years of Leadership/Military Science, score of Level 3 or higher in ELA or math, and Level 2 "Standard Nearly Met" or higher in other subject area

Career Technical Education (CTE) Pathway

Pathway completion with a grade of C- or better in the capstone course plus one of the Additional Criteria below:

- Smarter Balanced Summative Assessments:**

Level 3 or higher in ELA and at least a Level 2 in mathematics, or Level 3 or higher in mathematics and at least a Level 2 in ELA

- One semester/two quarters/two-trimesters of College Credit Courses with a grade of C- or better in academic/CTE subjects where college credits are awarded for each course

University of California (UC) and California State University (CSU) a-g requirements

Complete a-g course requirements with a grade of C- or better plus one of the Additional Criteria below:

- Smarter Balanced Summative Assessments:**

Level 3 or higher in ELA and at least a Level 2 in mathematics, or Level 3 or higher in mathematics and at least a Level 2 in ELA

- One semester/two quarters/two-trimesters of College Credit Courses with a grade of C- or better in academic/CTE subjects where college credits are awarded for each course
- Score of 3 on one AP exam or score of 4 on one IB exam
- Completion of CTE Pathway

WHY from **MENTAL HEALTH FIRST AID**
Teen Mental Health First Aid (MHFA) teaches teens to recognize signs of mental health and substance use challenges in their friends and peers.

49.5% of adolescents ages 13-18 live with a mental disorder. More than 1 in 5 (20.2%) of them experience a severe mental disorder. Source: National Institute of Mental Health

50% of all mental disorders begin by age 14, and 75% by the age of 24. Source: National Institute of Mental Health

WHAT IT COVERS

- Common signs and symptoms of mental health and substance use challenges.
- Common signs and symptoms of a mental health crisis, particularly suicide.
- The impact of school violence and bullying on mental health.
- How to open the conversation about mental health and substance use with friends.
- How to seek the help of a responsible and trusted adult.

WHO TAKES OR TEACHES MHFA?

- Teens to grades 10, 11, and 12 or ages 15-18.
- High schools, organizations partnering with a high school and providing organizations are eligible to teach MHFA.

THREE WAYS TO TEACH AND LEARN

- In-person: Lessons are conducted in person in six 45-minute sessions or three 90-minute sessions.
- Blended: Teens complete a self-paced online lesson, then participate in six live, instructor-led sessions. These instructor-led sessions can be:
 - Video conferenced.
 - In-person classes.
