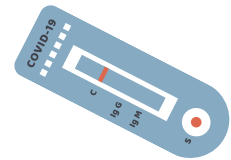

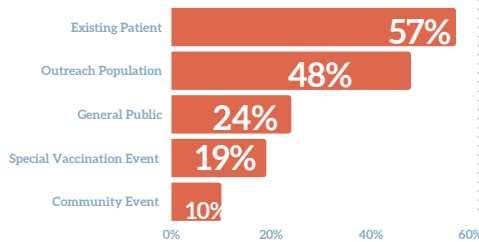

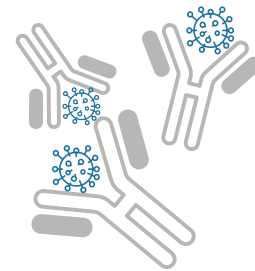

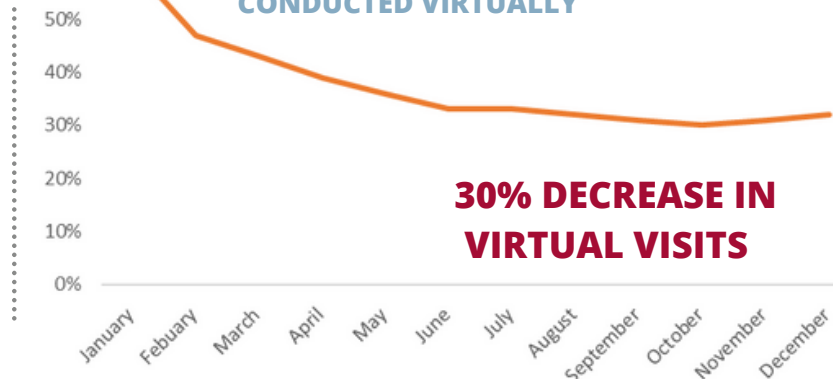

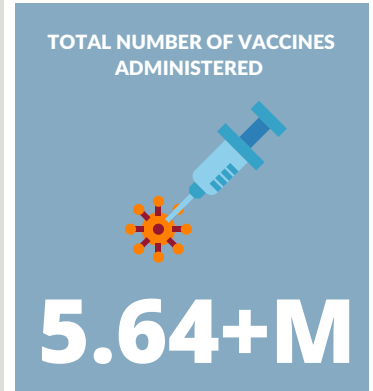
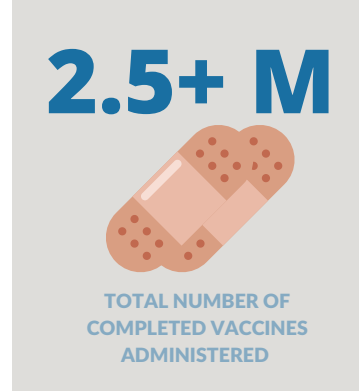
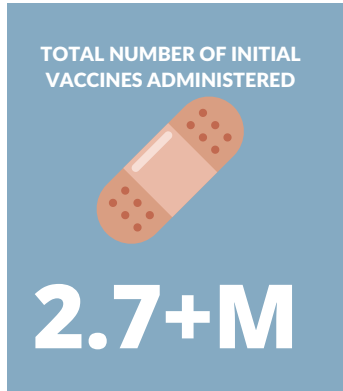

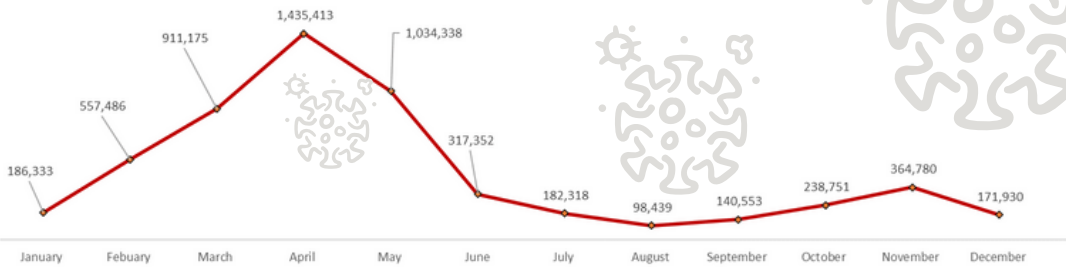

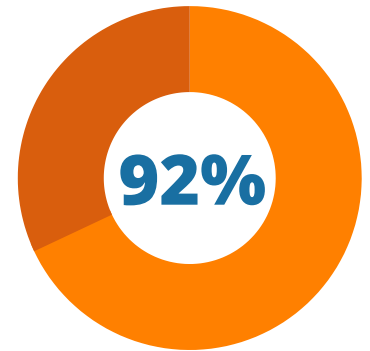

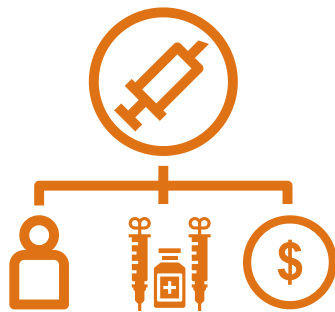
NUMBER OF VACCINES ADMINISTERED BY MONTH



VACCINES ADMINISTERED- IDENTIFIED AS RACIAL OR ETHNIC MINORITY GROUPS ⁽¹⁾

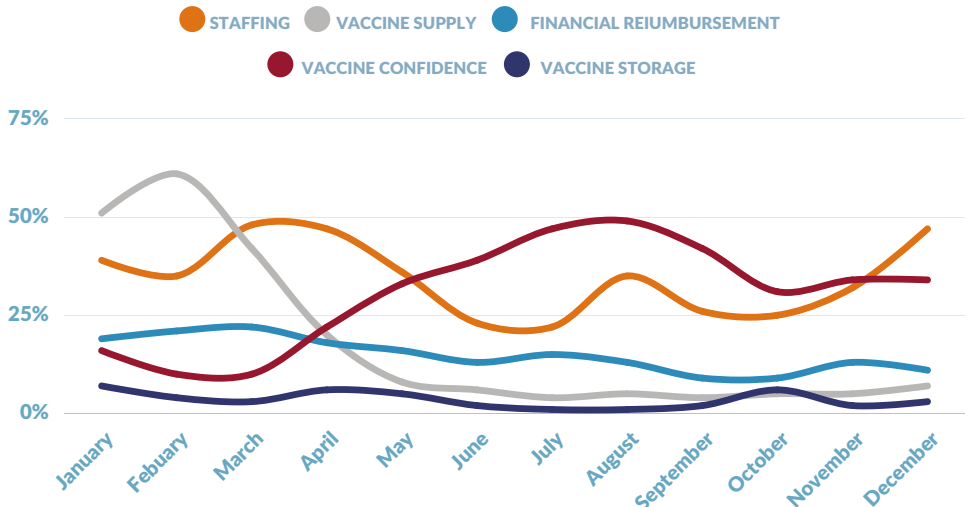


VACCINATION DISTRIBUTION
