IEHP OVERVIEW

- INLAND EMPIRE HEALTH PLAN (IEHP) IS ONE OF THE TOP 10 LARGEST MEDICAID HEALTH PLAN AND THE LARGEST NOT-FOR-PROFIT MEDICARE-MEDICAID PLAN IN THE COUNTRY.
- APPROXIMATELY I.6 MILLION MEMBERS ADULTS, CHILDREN AND FAMILIES IN RIVERSIDE & SAN BERNARDINO COUNTIES.
- OVER 3,000 EMPLOYEES.

Who is Eligible for Medi-Cal?

- Medi-Cal provides free or low-cost health coverage for:
- Children-regardless of immigration status
- Adults
- Children in foster care
- DACA students
- Former foster youth up to age 26
- Pregnant women with limited income and resources regardless of immigration status
- People of age 50+ regardless of immigration status Starting May 2022

Bus Passes

Monthly Pass

CTC will process subscription bus passes on the 20th of every month. The passes must be mailed out by the 23rd of each month.

Monthly Electronic Pass

CTC must provide the link to the Member within 7 days of the scheduled reservation.

Single Pass

CTC must provide electronic link or mail bus pass to the Member within 7 days of the scheduled reservation.



Enrollment Assistance

- IEHP's Enrollment Advisor Team is the first step for community members to receive assistance with obtaining benefits with:
- IEHP Manages health coverage for persons with Medi-Cal and Medicare
- **Medi-Cal -** Free health coverage for all ages who qualify
- Medicare Health coverage for persons 65+ and those with qualifying disabilities
- SSI Monetary assistance for disabled or low-income <u>adults</u> and <u>children</u>
- SSDI –Monetary assistance for disabled adults
- Covered California Low-cost health coverage



Behavioral Health (BH) Criteria & Eligibility

- ☐ Active Member w/ IEHP
- Seeking preventive services (children and adults)
- ☐ Mental health assessments
- ☐ Therapy and psychiatry (medication)
- ☐ No diagnosis is required

- Medi-Cal and Medi-Cal/Medicare Members can request BH Services by calling IEHP's call center. The referral will be made to an appropriate provider
- Appointments within 10 days of routine (non emergent) requests.
- IEHP coordinates care with all involved providers (county mental health, specialists etc)

*No authorization is required for initial visits for both psychiatry & therapy services.

STUDENT BEHAVIORAL HEALTH INCENTIVE PROGRAM

SBHIP



The Student Behavioral Health Incentive Program (SBHIP) is phase I of the Children and Youth Behavioral Health Initiative (CYBHI), a 5-year 4.4-billion-dollar vision that seeks to reimagine the systems that support the behavioral health needs for ALL children and youth in California. Supported through Assembly Bill 133: Section 5961.4, a pathway was established to develop sustainable partnerships, thereby increasing access to prevention, early intervention, and behavioral health services in grades TK-12. The incentive payments, directed through the Managed Care plans in California (\$389 million) are designated to meet predefined goals and metrics over a three-year period (January I, 2022— December 31, 2024).

Objectives:

- Break down silos and improve coordination of child and adolescent student behavioral health services through increased communication with schools, school affiliated programs, managed care providers, counties, and mental health providers.
- Increase the number of TK-12 students enrolled in Medi-Cal receiving behavioral health services through schools, school-affiliated providers, county behavioral health departments, and county offices of education.
- Increase prevention and early intervention behavioral health services on or near school campuses.
- Address health equity gap, inequities, and disparities in access to behavioral health services.
- Sustain and expand interventions implemented past calendar year 2024.



The Health Navigator team leads strategic initiatives with Community Partners, San Bernardino & Riverside School Districts & organizations focused on ACEs reduction.


The Health Navigators work directly with IEHP Members in their homes and communities focusing on health navigation, linkage to various community-based organizations, medical specialists, community and health plan resources.











A CLOSER LOOK: HEALTH NAVIGATOR PROGRAM



BACKGROUND

Collaborate with the both a variety of schools in both San Bernardino & Riverside County and IEHP's Health Navigator Program to provide education and services for underserved communities within the district

OBJECTIVE

Seek to provide targeted services to identified students & their families (ex: missing immunizations, behind on well child exams, etc.).

Empower IEHP Members to use preventive services such as mental health & wellness resources, well child exams, immunizations, etc. and receive care for their chronic conditions (i.e., Asthma, diabetes, etc.).

OUTCOMES

- · Provide education on appropriate utilization of:
 - Nurse Advice Line
 - · Urgent Care Clinics
 - · Behavioral Health
 - · Primary Care Providers
- Connect members to community resources and to internal IEHP departments based on need.
- Build strong partnership with school staff (counselors, health aide, Principal, teachers and office personal, etc.)

IMPACT ON THE COMMUNITY

- Background:
 - 14 yr. old referred by teacher
 - Language barrier
 - Experiencing bullying & suffers from depression
- Member needs:
 - Preventive Services
 - Behavioral Health Resources
 - Food disparity
- HN Services provided:
 - PCP appointments scheduled
 - Connection made to IEHP BH Department
 - Food box delivered to family
