Resource Desert


- Nutrition: Six of our districts don't have grocery stores in their areas.
- Health: lack of health clinics and hospitals.
 People drive down the hill for specialty medical services.
- Peer Programs: no Boys and Girls Clubs or YMCA programs.
- Transportation: local public transportation can take hours to get to different locations.
- Neighborhoods: lack of sidewalks, streets, and lighting makes unsafe.

- Centrally located


Currently:
